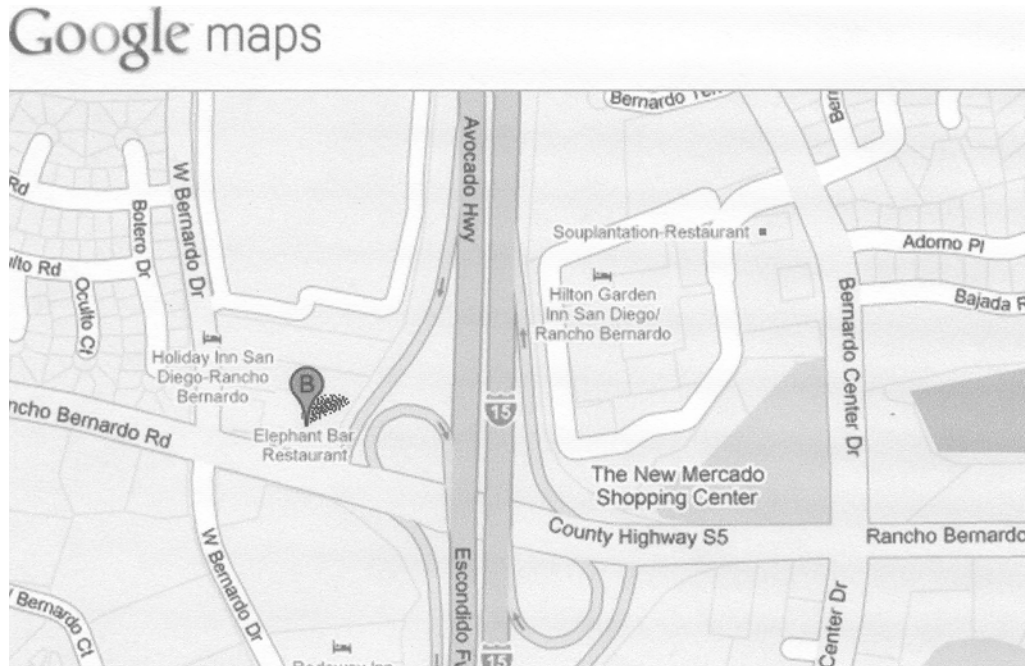
THANK YOU, ROSIE, FOR THE FABULOUS LUNCHEON!!!

As requested, here's the recipe for the dessert that **Rosie** served.

THE CLOSEST THING TO ROBERT REDFORD

1cup flour

1cup chopped pecans

1cup sugar

1 sm. pkg. vanilla instant pudding

½ cup butter, softened

1-8 oz. pkg. chocolate instant pudding

3 cups milk

1-9 oz pkg. Cool Whip

Mix flour and softened butter together, add pecans. Press into 9X13 inch greased pan.

Bake at 350 for 15 to 20 minutes or until slightly browned. Cool.

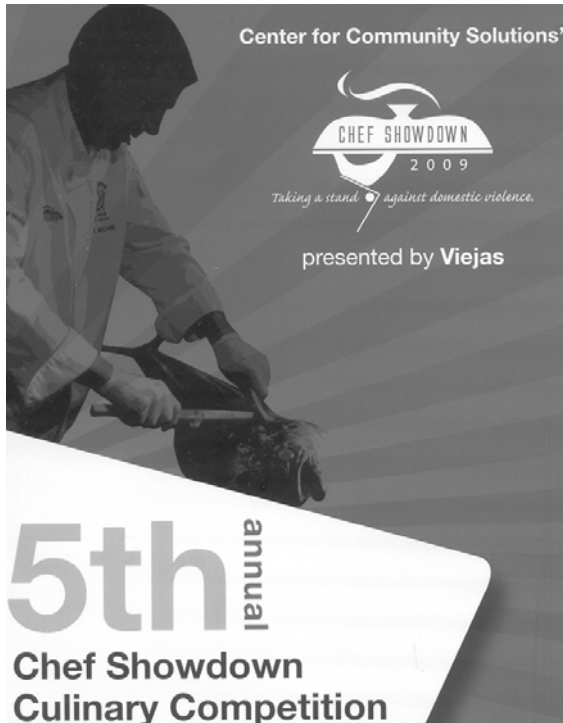
Beat cream cheese and sugar until smooth. Fold in ½ of the Cool Whip.

Spread over cooled crust.

Mix puddings and milk together and beat until smooth and thick.

Spread over the middle layer. Top with remaining Cool Whip. Grate chocolate over top for garnish. Serves 12.
