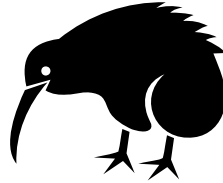

SAN DIEGO KIWI CHAPTER CHRISTMAS CHARITY

This year, the San Diego Kiwi Board is recommending that the Chapter members donate gift cards to the San Diego Rescue Mission. One of the main concerns of the center is housing for one year, not only for single women who are attempting to get their life in order, but mothers with children as well. Those not fortunate enough to be able to live in the residence may stay, in emergency housing for the night and leave in the morning. I was told that it is heart rendering to watch the homeless mothers helping their children with their homework for the next school day.

The greatest need for these women is for clothes, toiletries, etc. To this end, it is suggested that gift cards be given for Target, Wal-Mart, etc. These stores have pharmacies, so they are also able to get prescriptions filled for a lesser amount. As with last year, we ask that, if you plan to give cards for \$25.00 or more, you break the larger amount into several cards of smaller denominations.

You can be assured that your donation to these women will be received with overwhelming gratitude. I cannot even imagine the depth of their despair and fear.

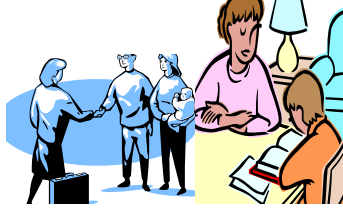

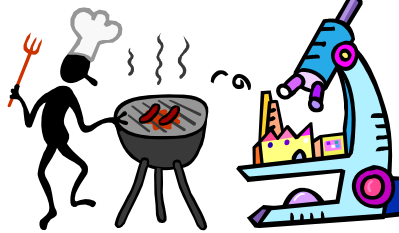
