The **DeSoto Savannah** on Liberty Street is our host hotel...a boutique-style hotel that includes many amenities and is home to a SCAD art gallery. Reservations can be made on the Convention website: **thekiwiclub.org** or by calling 866 810-5325. Rooms are available April 22-27, \$229 per night for 2 doubles or 1 King bed. All rooms have hairdryers, coffee machines, and data ports with complimentary Wi-Fi access. You will find 2 excellent restaurants in the Hotel along with an exercise room, swimming pool, and more. Just a few steps outside our front door, restaurants, and shopping are plentiful.

The small and easy-to-navigate Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport is approximately 20 minutes from the hotel. Taxis, town cars, Lyft, and Uber are easily booked when you arrive in the baggage claim area or by preplanned reservation. If you are planning to drive, the hotel has in-and-out valet parking for \$38/day. There are several other garages in the area. We suggest you check in with the hotel about reserving a spot for the days of your booking.

Following your hotel check-in, you will find the Kiwi Convention Registration and Welcome Center in the Foyer, where you will receive your registration materials, optional event wristband, and a surprise or two.

Located in The Pulaski Room, the Hospitality/Memorabilia Center will include a variety of items of interest, including a tribute to the graduating classes of 1973-74 and a very special Stewardess/Flight Attendant uniform Auction, compiled by Traveling Uniform Coordinator Christine Strommer Moeckel. Chris has arranged a special Auction of Uniforms, in their entirety---look for them in Hospitality and by the Reservation/Welcome Desk. Adjacent you will find the popular Kiwi Boutique available for purchasing an assortment of items. As in the past, an Auction of AA and Kiwi-related items will benefit NKF and Wings. An address will be provided where to send them, or you can bring them to the Convention. Tuesday, April 23rd will kick off our activities for arriving Kiwi attendees. The Past Presidents Luncheon will be held at 11:30, and an early evening invitational reception for Delegates and Officer Candidates will be held on the 15th floor in the Harborview Room.

The Members at Large (MAL) will caucus on Wednesday, April 24th at 10 am in the Lafayette Suite.

Our pre-luncheon cash-bar cocktail reception begins at 11 am in the foyer of the Cumberland Dining Room. *Fete des Peaches n Cream* opening luncheon will begin at noon with the introduction of the classes of 1973-74, who are celebrating their *50th Anniversary*. This will be an open-seating affair where you will draw a table number as you enter the dining room. This allows us to meet former and new friends while sharing our stories and fun experiences.

A very special *Gentry Gumbo & Ghosts* Optional Event will take place from 5:30 – 9:30 pm. Hop aboard the famous Savannah trolley where your guide will share Savannah's historical past en route to "Lady & Sons" restaurant. This landmark property is owned and operated by celebrity chef Paula Deen, where her hospitality reigns and appetites are entertained. Our return to the hotel will be spirited and thrill your senses on our very own Kiwi Ghost Tour. This exceptional optional evening is offered at \$75 pp and can include guests…be sure to include their names on the reservation form.

Preceding the Delegates' Business meeting on Thursday, April 25th, attendees are encouraged to join special breakout sessions beginning at 8:30 am. The topics will enrich your knowledge of The Kiwi Club and our long-term philanthropy. At noon, immediately following the Delegate Business Session, the Installation of 2024-26 Officers will be held. All attendees are welcome to attend and raise a glass of bubbly to the success of the incoming board and The Kiwi Club.

Our last evening together will be shared at our *Magnolia Soiree* closing banquet. We will listen, dance, and jive to the sounds of the *17 South Band*. The evening will begin at 6:00 pm with a cash bar reception in the foyer of the Magnolia Ballroom. At 7:00 pm you will be welcomed into the elegance and warmth of the candlelit Magnolia Dining room.

Installing the app: On the screen that opens on an iPhone, you will see an option to "Add to Home Screen". If you are using an Android, tap the three dots in the top right corner for this feature. **Do this now!**

Once added, tap the app icon from your home screen to open it. Navigate using the menu button at the bottom of the screen. Simply tap an icon to visit a page and select individual items for more details.

"Savannah Sojourn" includes Southern cuisine, "sipping and strolling", the arts, culture, shopping, sightseeing, and catching up with dear friends. Reservation Deadline is April 10, 2024

Please follow the instructions below for completing the attached Banquet Seating Form. Each table will seat eight (8) persons. This form is needed for **each** attending Kiwi by the deadline – no exceptions. This form must accompany your registration form and check.

- 1. Chapter Members: In addition to returning this form, give your name and the names of any guests to your chapter president if you wish to sit at your chapter table. If more than ten people wish to be seated together, we will do our best to accommodate the overflow at a nearby table. If you prefer to sit with a chapter other than your own, be sure your name is on their list. If sitting with a friend, indicate the friend's name or names. Make sure this information appears on the forms of all parties.
- 2. Members at Large: If you wish to be seated with friends at their chapter table, please indicate which chapter. Remember to make sure your name is included on their chapter list. If you have a particular person with whom you wish to be seated, please put that person's name on your form and make sure your name is on that person's form. We will accommodate where possible.
- **3.** Current National Board and Support Staff: You will be seated at reserved tables unless otherwise noted. Be sure to include guest names. In addition to submitting this form, please advise National President, Stephanie McCauley Butler, of your seating choice.
- 4. National Officer Candidates: *If you are elected* to a national office, you will be seated at reserved tables unless otherwise noted. Be sure to include guest names. In addition to this form, please advise National President Stephanie McCauley Butler of your seating choice following your election.
- **5.** Past National Presidents and Honorary Members: You have the option of being seated at a specially reserved table. If you prefer sitting elsewhere, please note on this form. Be sure to include guest names.
