# 1946-1953 Winter

Fitted navy jacket and matching skirt. Collarless jacket has single row of three buttons. The long skirt is slightly flared at the bottom. A white short sleeved blouse is worn open at the neck. It was worn with a navy overseas cap. *Photo: Courtesy of Joni Hayes Buck* 



# 1964-1966 Summer

Powder blue with a triangular front closure with 3 cloth covered buttons. Three quarter length sleeves and a peplum flare in the back. It was worn with a white blouse, darted front with pearl buttons. *Photo: courtesy of Joni Hayes Buck* 



# 1966-1967 Summer

Double breasted jacket with eight covered cloth buttons. A flared skirt worn with a crinkle knit blouse and pill box hat. The color was called Summer Sea Island Blue. *Photo: Mary Thrasher* 



# 1967-1969 American Beauty (Red Dress)

The first one-piece uniform and a shorter hemline (initially above the knee). Regulation hairbows replaced a hat, white "Go-Go" boots which could be worn off the aircraft, but white patent leather shoes were required inflight. The dress was available in red, white, and blue and could be worn with an optional red, white, and blue vinyl belt. White vinyl bag to transport stewardess manual and personal items. *Photo: file* 



#### 1969-1971 Americana (Plaid)

The uniform came in two solid colors, blue and red as well as the plaid. The skirt elastic waistband and included a vest and white blouse with ascot. It was worn with navy blue hose and special navy shoes with red accent band. An optional "Davy Crockett" style raccoon hat complete with tail. *Photo: file convention 2022* 



# 1971-1973 American Field Flower (Navy)

Introduced in three colors, red, white, and blue. It included a matching jacket, color trim on the collars, hems sleeves and neck. They were mini skirt length and often worn with bell bottom pants or, later hot pants underneath. *Photo: Courtesy of Paulette Grayson King*
