

THE KIWI CLUB THE KIWI AWARD PROCEDURES & GUIDELINES

The Kiwi Award is granted to honor and recognize an individual Kiwi or organization for continuous – not less than five years – dedication, assistance, support, or promotion of a local Kiwi chapter or The Kiwi Club. This is the most prestigious award that a chapter can bestow on a member, MAL or a person/organization whose performance has been outstanding.

Procedure

- 1. A member or person/organization is selected by the chapter's board based on the recommendations of the board or a chapter member.
- 2. Thirty (30) days' notice must be given to chapter members of the board's intent to honor said Kiwi or person/organization; the members will then cast their votes to either approve or disapprove.
- 3. After a unanimous affirmative vote by chapter members casting ballots, this form is submitted to the National Executive Board for consideration.
- 4. Upon unanimous approval by the NEB, a certificate, signed by the National President, will be sent to the chapter president for presentation to the recipient of the award. The honoree will be announced at convention.
- 5. **NOTE:** Any member of The Kiwi Club may submit for consideration a member at large or a corporate individual who fulfills the criteria shown here. However, the nomination will be sent directly to the NEB to be reviewed and acted upon. The certificate will be sent directly to the person who submitted the nomination form and the recipient's name will be announced at convention.
