



THE KIWI CLUB WEBSITE VENDOR CONTRACT

This contract is between _____ (Vendor) and The Kiwi Club (Club), an organization of former and current American Airlines flight attendants. Vendor agrees to all policies set forth below by signing and returning the contract to the President of the Club for approval by the Club's National Executive Board (NEB). The contract will be in effect for one year beginning _____, and ending _____, as stated within the conditions and time frame given in this document.

1. Vendor will pay \$50.00 (fifty dollars) U.S. currency to the Club for inclusion on the Club's website for a period of one (1) year beginning with the receipt of the signed contract by the President of the Club. A check for this amount is to be included with the signed contract. If the Vendor is declined for any reason, the above-stated monies will be reimbursed to the Vendor in a timely manner. All prices are subject to change after initial contracts expire and, if necessary, a new contract issued.
2. The NEB will determine the validity of any Vendor making application to the Club for doing business on the Club's website. A simple majority vote by the NEB will be required for acceptance.
3. No risqué or material judged in poor taste by the NEB will be accepted for inclusion on the website.
4. The Club will not be responsible for any monetary transactions between Vendor and its customers, nor will the Club be responsible for any sales, nor provide any information, referrals, or statements of policy to said customers.
5. Vendor is responsible for content of display/ad, including artwork, establishing sales policies, sales transactions, order forms, customer service, and any and all matters pertaining to the sale of their product, all within the parameters stated above. A copy of the display/ad shall be sent, along with the Vendor's application, for approval by the NEB of the Club.
6. Any complaint from customers or Vendor – regardless of concern – that is received by the Club's NEB or Website Hostess will be reviewed by the NEB. Upon review of any complaints received, the NEB will decide whether or not the contract will be terminated or remain intact. If the contract is terminated, Vendor will be notified immediately. All complaints from customers will be forwarded to the Vendor.
7. After this contract is approved and signed by representatives of both Vendor and the NEB, the Website Hostess will incorporate the approved display/ad into the Club's website and notify Vendor. The ad will be posted on the website no later than ten working days after the ad and contract approval has been received by the Website Hostess.
8. Vendor must give the NEB and/or Website Hostess at least thirty (30) days' notice prior to canceling the contract with the Club. All outstanding monies will become the property of the Club.
9. If for any reason, the Vendor violates this contract, the contract will become null and void, and any outstanding monies will become the property of the Club.
